Access NI Assessment before they can work with young people. The Access NI Assessment clearance form should be attached to this form.

Referees

- Two referees are required.
 Suitable responsible people might be Teacher, Clergy, Garda/Police Officer, Peace Commissioner, Employer, Scouter.
 (Applicant should seek their consent before nominating them)
- However only one referee can be a Scouter.
- The person who signs the Approval cannot act as a Referee.
- · Members of your family should not act as a Referee
- Each referee should be aware that they are referees and will be contacted in the future.
- Both completed Reference Forms must accompany this form.


